ORDER

A status conference was held in this matter. The case was remanded by the NH Supreme Court on the issue of inevitable discovery. On or before end of business on Monday, March 23, 2026, the State shall inform the Court and defense of whether it will be seeking to introduce additional evidence on the issue of inevitable discovery. If so, the State must indicate the identity of any witnesses and proposed subject matter of the testimony/evidence. The defense shall have until March 27, 2026 to file indicate whether they will be presenting any responsive testimony/evidence and, if so, the identity of witnesses and proposed subject matter. The Court is strongly inclined to allow additional evidence on the limited issue of inevitable discovery, if the State or defense want to present such evidence. On or before April 10, 2026, the State shall file any supplemental memoranda on the inevitable discovery issue. Any objection or response to that filing by the defense must be filed on or before April 17, 2026. Any further hearing, including presentation of evidence, shall be at a time to be coordinated with counsel the week of April 20, 2026. So ordered.
