DEFENDANT’S NOTICE REGARDING RESPONSIVE EVIDENCE

NOW COMES the defendant, Logan Clegg, by and through counsel, Thomas Barnard, Esq., and Maya Dominguez, Esq., and, pursuant to this Court’s order of March 20, 2026, respectfully provides this notice about “whether [Clegg] will be presenting any responsive testimony/evidence.” This Court’s March 20 order required that the State, “[o]n or before the end of business on Monday, March 23, 2026, . . . inform the Court and [Clegg] of whether it will be seeking to introduce additional evidence on the issue of evitable discovery.” On March 23, 2026, the State submitted a pleading entitled “State’s Witness List.” This pleading fails to identify any evidence that is either new or different from the evidence already presented at the three-day evidentiary hearing held on May 24-26, 2023. In reliance on the State’s March 23 pleading, Clegg hereby notifies this Court and the State that he does not seek to present any responsive evidence, as the State’s pleading indicates that there will be no new or different evidence to respond to.
