STATE'S WITNESS LIST

NOW COMES the State of New Hampshire, by and through its attorneys, the Office of the Attorney General, and notifies this court and the defendant of the witnesses it may call at the evidentiary hearing scheduled to take place the week of April 20, 2026:

1. On October 23, 2023, after a jury trial, the defendant was convicted of two counts of knowing second-degree murder, two alternative counts of reckless second-degree murder, four counts of falsifying physical evidence, and one count of being a felon in possession of a firearm. The defendant's convictions all relate to the deaths of Stephen and Djeswende Reid in Concord, NH on April 18, 2022, and subsequent actions the defendant took to conceal his role in the murders.

2. The defendant appealed his conviction to the New Hampshire Supreme Court. On March 17, 2026, the Court issued an order vacating the trial court's denial of the defendant's pre-trial motion to suppress and remanded for the limited purpose of deciding whether the defendant's motion to suppress should have been denied on the basis of the inevitable discovery doctrine.

3. On March 20, 2026, this court granted the State until the end of business on Monday, March 23, 2026, to provide notice to this court and to the defendant of whether it intends to present additional evidence on the issue of inevitable discovery. This court ordered the State to indicate the identity of any witnesses and proposed subject matter of the testimony/evidence.

4. In accordance with this court's order, the State provides the following list of witnesses it may call, along with the subject matter of the anticipated testimony:
