STATUS ORDER

A status hearing was held in this case today. Attorney Zaino appeared for the defendant. Attorney Devine and Attorney Grelek-McKeon appeared for the State. Mr. Holloway attended the hearing by WebEx from the jail. Attorney Zaino has had telephone contact with Mr. Holloway. He recently visited him at the jail. Additionally, he is in the process of reviewing the voluminous discovery materials. Attorney Zaino and Mr. Holloway have discussed their theory of defense and approach to the pending charges.

The Court ruled on a series of pro-se motions filed by Mr. Holloway prior to the hearing. Attorney Zaino will file any appropriate motions in view of the Court's rulings. Mr. Holloway spoke to his present medical condition and the need to address it before the next hearing. The Court advised him that it will address any motion related to his medical condition and the Covid -19 situation at the jail on an expedited basis before the next status hearing.

The Court and the parties will structure a pretrial schedule at the next status hearing. It is the Court's intention to hold periodic status hearings in this case as it moves towards a trial.
