ORDER

The Court conducted a hearing today on the State's Motion in Limine to Preclude the Defendant's Use of His Own Statements (Index #227), to which the defendant objects. (Index #265.) The State explained that it intends to present evidence of most of the statements the defendant made in his June 21, 2019 and June 24, 2019 interviews with law enforcement but objects to the defendant's use of any of his other statements because they are inadmissible hearsay. The Court GRANTS the State's motion as to the defendant's own statements, other than those he made in said interviews, subject to the defendant's right to move, outside of the jury's presence, for the admission of any such statement on specific evidentiary grounds.
