ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RIGHTS - CLASS B MISDEMEANOR

I, Anna Barbara Hantz Marconi of Stratham NH

have been charged in the Merrimack County Superior Court with the following offense(s):

Criminal Solicitation of Misuse of Position, (RSA 629:2, I) (RSA 21-G:23)

The statements made below shall apply to each and every complaint, if there be more than one, to which I intend to plead no contest.

If I am not a citizen of the United States, I understand that conviction of the crime(s) for which I intend to plead no contest may have immigration consequences, including but not limited to, deportation from the United States, exclusion from admission into the United States, or denial of naturalization pursuant to the laws of the United States.

- I understand that the complaint is one accusing me of a Class A Misdemeanor(s), and that I have the right to be represented by a lawyer of my own choosing and at my own expense, and that if I am unable to afford a lawyer the Court will appoint one for me subject to an order of reimbursement based on my ability to pay.
- I understand that the complaint is one accusing me of a Class B Misdemeanor(s), and that I have the right to be represented by a lawyer of my own choosing and at my own expense.
- I am represented by Richard Guerriero NH Bar #10530, a lawyer admitted to practice in New Hampshire. I am satisfied with my lawyer and all explanations have been clear.
- I do not want a lawyer. I understand and know what I am doing. I hereby waive my right to a lawyer.

I understand that I do not have to plead no contest and that even after signing this form I still do not have to plead no contest.

I understand that by pleading no contest to the charge(s) that I am giving up the following constitutional rights as to the charge(s):

MY RIGHT to a speedy and public trial.

MY RIGHT to see, hear and question all witnesses. This gives me the opportunity and right to confront my accusers and cross-examine them myself or through my attorney.

MY RIGHT to present evidence and call witnesses in my favor and to testify on my own behalf.

MY RIGHT to remain silent and not testify at a trial.

MY RIGHT to have the Judge *ORDER* into court all evidence and witnesses in my favor.

MY RIGHT not to be convicted unless the State proves that I am guilty beyond a reasonable doubt with respect to all elements of the charge(s), which have been explained to me.

MY RIGHT to keep out evidence, including confessions, illegally obtained.

MY RIGHT to a trial before a jury and my right to appeal issues of law to the Supreme Court. (Class A Misd.)

I GIVE UP ALL THE ABOVE RIGHTS OF MY OWN FREE WILL. I understand that by pleading **NO CONTEST** I am admitting to or not contesting the truth of the charge(s) against me in the complaint(s) and that on the Judge's acceptance of my **NO CONTEST** plea, a conviction(s) will be entered against me.

ATTACHMENT TO ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND WAIVER OF RIGHTS

The following are the terms of the fully negotiated plea agreement between the State, represented by Deputy Attorney General James Boffetti, Senior Assistant Attorney General Dan Jimenez, and Assistant Attorney General Joseph Fincham, and the Defendant, represented by Attorney Richard Guerriero, Attorney Jonathan Kotlier, and Attorney Oliver Bloom. The State and the defense agree that, in addition to the terms in the acknowledgement and waiver of rights, the following terms shall apply in this plea agreement.

The plea shall be nolo contendere / no contest to the charge of Criminal Solicitation of Misuse of Position as a Class B Misdemeanor.

Justice Hantz Marconi and the State agree to waive an offer of proof.

Justice Hantz Marconi's counsel will state at the time of the entry of the no contest plea that she is not contesting that the State could prove beyond a reasonable doubt that she solicited Governor Sununu to seek information regarding the investigation of Geno Marconi.

Justice Hantz Marconi will pay a fine of \$1,200 due on the day of the plea/sentencing hearing.

The State shall confirm during the colloquy that the State agrees that the offense of which Justice Hantz Marconi is being convicted falls outside of the definition of "serious crime" in N.H. Sup. Ct. R. 37(9)(b) because it does not involve a felony nor does any necessary element of the charge, as determined by statutory or common law definitions, involve interference with the administration of justice, false swearing, misrepresentation, fraud, deceit, bribery, extortion, misappropriation, theft, or an attempt or a conspiracy or solicitation of another to commit a "serious crime."

All other currently pending charges against Justice Hantz Marconi shall be dismissed, and no other charges will be filed by the State against Justice Hantz Marconi arising out of the matters in the discovery of this case.
