

STATE'S ASSENTED-TO MOTION TO EXTEND DISCOVERY DEADLINE

NOW COMES the State of New Hampshire, by and through its attorneys, the Office of the Attorney General, and respectfully requests this Motion to Extend the State's Deadline to Review and Provide Any Favorable or Exculpatory Evidence, and in support thereof states as follows:

1. The defendant has been indicted for two counts of Second Degree Murder.
2. On March 24, 2021, the Court issued an order on the defendant's Motion to Compel "Outstanding" Discovery, namely, the discovery file in State v. Holloway, No. 226-2019-CR-814 (the "Holloway File"). In its decision, the Court ordered the State to obtain the Holloway file from the Hillsborough County Attorney's Office, review all investigative narratives and reports, as well as any witness statements contained within the File, and provide any favorable or exculpatory evidence contained therein to the defendant within thirty (30) days of the Court's order. The State's deadline is currently April 23, 2021.
3. The State received the Holloway File on April 8, 2021 from the Hillsborough County Attorney's Office. The file contains approximately 1,403 pages of discovery, as well as twenty-nine (29) compact discs, presumably containing recorded interviews.

4. In light of having only just received the Holloway file on April 8th, as well as the quantity of materials contained within the File, the State requests an additional fourteen (14) days beyond the current deadline to complete its review of the File and provide any evidence to the defendant in accordance with the Court's order. The new deadline would be May 7, 2021.

5. Counsel for the defendant, Eliana Forciniti, Esq., was contacted regarding the State's request and assents thereto.

6. Should it become clear as the May 7th deadline approaches that further time is required to complete the review, the State reserves the right to request such additional time.

WHEREFORE, the State of New Hampshire respectfully requests that this Honorable Court:

- (A) Extend the State's deadline to review and provide evidence by an additional fourteen (14) days; and
- (B) Grant such further relief as may be deemed just and proper.
