**BOSTON GLOBE MEDIA PARTNERS, LLC'S MOTION TO ACCEPT
FILING OF HEARING MEMORANDUM**

Now Comes Boston Globe Media Partners, LLC., publisher of the Boston Globe, and, in accordance with Superior Court Rule 11(a), moves the Court to accept the late filing of its Hearing Memorandum in Support of Petition for Access to Juror Names.

In its October 9, 2022 Order at page 3, the Court stated that “[a]t least five business days before the hearing” any other party may file a hearing memorandum or brief. The hearing is scheduled for February 9, 2023.

Wanting its filing to address the legal argument made by Amicus Counsel, counsel for the Boston Globe did not have sufficient time on February 2 or 3, 2023 to prepare its Hearing Memorandum and moves the Court to accept its late filing today, February 6, 2023.

As required by Superior Court Rule 11(c), counsel for the Boston Globe has made a good faith attempt to obtain the concurrence to the relief requested by this motion by advising counsel of record this morning of the motion and the Hearing Memorandum. As of this filing, Amicus Counsel expressed concurrence; counsel for the State takes no position; counsel for the New Hampshire Association of Criminal Defense Attorneys stated as an amicus he was uncertain whether the Association has standing to take a position; and the Coos County Attorney's Office has yet to respond.

WHEREFORE, the Boston Globe respectfully requests the Court to grant this motion and accept the late filing of its Hearing Memorandum and such other relief as may be necessary and proper.
