NOW COMES the State of New Hampshire, by and through its attorney, the Office of the Attorney General, and respectfully requests that this Honorable Court allow members of the victim’s family to attend the October 7, 2025 motions hearing via Webex. In support of its request, the State says as follows:

1. The defendant is currently charged with first-degree murder, and other charges related to the murder of Caitlyn Naffziger (DOB: 3/201992) which occurred on February 29, 2024.
2. A hearing on pending motions has been scheduled for Tuesday, October 7, 2025 at 2:30 P.M.
3. Several family members of Ms. Naffziger are located outside of the State of New Hampshire and would like to attend the hearing.
4. As such, the State is requesting that the Webex system be activated for the purpose of allowing remote attendance for persons who are unable to attend the hearing in person.
5. The defendant, through counsel, assents to the State’s Motion.
