**STATE'S MOTION TO APPEAR AT ARRAIGNMENT HEARING VIA WEBEX**

NOW COMES the State of New Hampshire, by and through its attorney, the Office of the Attorney General, and respectfully requests that this Honorable Court allow the State and members of the victim's family to attend the July 1, 2024, arraignment hearing via Webex. In support of its request, the State says as follows:

1. The defendant is currently charged with first-degree murder, and other charges related to the murder of Caitlyn Naffziger (DOB: 3/10/1992) which occurred on February 29, 2024.

2. An arraignment hearing is scheduled for July 1, 2024, at 9:00 A.M. in the Coös County Superior Court.

3. Upon information and belief, the defendant intends to waive further arraignment. If, however, a hearing is to be held, several family members of Ms. Naffziger, and of the defendant, are located outside of the State of New Hampshire and would like to attend the arraignment hearing.

4. Given the nature of this hearing and its anticipated length, as well as the defendant's appearance over Webex, the State requests the ability to appear via Webex.

5. Counsel for the defendant, Hanna Kinne, assents to the State's Motion.

WHEREFORE, the State respectfully requests that this Honorable Court:

- A. Grant the State's Motion; and,
- B. Allow the State and family members of the parties to attend the July 1, 2024, arraignment hearing over Webex; and,
- C. Grant such further relief as may be just and proper.
