**ORDER**

The Court has issued an Order on Pending Motions (Under Seal) this day on the Defendant's Motion to Dismiss and the Objection thereto (Indices ## 86 & 87) and the State's Motion to Preclude and Objection thereto (Indices ## 74 & 80). The latter two filings were filed under seal.

The Court states that it attempted to write the Order on the Motion to Preclude in such a manner that revealed no material confidential information. The Court hereby notifies the parties that the Order on Pending Motions will be unsealed and will become a public document fourteen (14) days after the Clerk's Notice of Decision is issued with respect to said Order, consistent with applicable provisions of Crim. Rule Proc. 50. If any party seeks to seal any of the information contained in said Order, that party shall file a Motion to Seal in compliance with Crim. Rule Proc. 50 before that date, and said party shall file a proposed redacted version of the Order for the Court's consideration. Any agreements between counsel as to the scope of any redactions shall be viewed favorably, however, a "blanket seal" as to the entire Order will be viewed unfavorably, under the circumstances.
