

ASSENTED-TO MOTION TO EXTEND DEADLINE

The State of New Hampshire, by and through counsel, moves with the plaintiffs' assent to extend its deadline to file a reply to the plaintiffs' objection to its motion for summary judgment, stating as follows:

1. Per Rule 13A, the State's reply memorandum is due on September 7.
