MOTION TO EXTEND DEADLINE

NOW COMES the defendant, Adam Montgomery, by and through counsel, Caroline L. Smith, Esq., and respectfully requests this Honorable Court extend the deadline for motions to suppress to August 22, 2022. In support of this request, the following is stated:

1. The defendant obtained an extension for a motion to suppress due to additional information the State had not yet provided pertinent to the motion. The State subsequently provided additional body cam video.
2. In a recent conversation with the State, the within counsel learned that there is an additional body cam video that is directly relevant to the motion that has not yet been provided. The State expects to provide the video at least by Monday, August 15, 2021. Accordingly, the defendant requests an additional 10 days to file the motion.
3. During the course of preparing the Motion contemplated at the time of the first Motion to Extend Deadline, the within counsel recognized an additional issue that should be subject to a Motion to Suppress. She requests that the extension apply to the additional issue as well.
4. The State has agreed to an additional ten day extension of the deadline in order to permit the defense to view the additional body cam video to complete the Motion to Suppress as well as to research and prepare an additional motion to suppress.

WHEREFORE, Adam Montgomery respectfully requests this Honorable Court extend the deadline for Motions to Suppress to August 22, 2022.




