INDIVIDUAL CASESTRUCTURING ORDERS

The clerk shall place the individual Meehan case, 217-2020-CV-00026 on the calendar for a **two to four week jury trial in mid-April 2024.**

The clerk shall also set aside places on the calendar for **two to four week jury trials in June 2024 and September 2024** for such other of these consolidated cases as will be agreed upon later by the parties. The court is hopeful that the June and September trial can include more than one plaintiff.

With respect to the Meehan case:

1. The State defendant shall respond to the plaintiff's outstanding discovery requests within 90 days.
2. Statutory expert disclosure by the plaintiffs by October 1, 2023.
Statutory expert disclosure by the defendants by January 3, 2024.
3. Summary judgment motions due 120 days prior to jury selection.
4. Daubert motions that involve witness testimony due 90 days prior to jury selection.
5. Motions in limine due 45 days prior to jury selection.
6. The parties shall engage in ADR prior to trial.

Further orders shall be issued with respect to the June and September 2024 trials once particular cases are selected.
