**ORDER RELATING TO CONTRACTOR CASES**

If a plaintiff files an affidavit or declaration in support of a claim that the discovery rule tolled the statute of limitations, the plaintiff shall provide automatic discovery of:

1. Any document cited in the affidavit or declaration; and
2. Any document in the plaintiff's possession, custody or control that refers or relates to any specific event mentioned in the affidavit or declaration.

Additionally, if plaintiff relies on an expert affidavit, declaration or report, plaintiff shall provide a statutory expert disclosure.

In the event that a defendant submits a declaration or affidavit in opposition to plaintiff's discovery rule argument, that defendant will provide the same discovery to the plaintiff.
