MOTION TO EXTEND EXPERT DISCLOSURE DEADLINE

NOW COMES Eric Sweeney, by and through counsel, Lauren Prusiner, Shea Sennett, and Morgan Taggart-Hampton and respectfully requests this Court extend his deadline for disclosure of one expert report, in the above cited matter.

In support of this Motion, it is stated:

1. Eric is charged with three counts of first degree murder and falsifying physical evidence.

2. Eric has previously requested an extension of this deadline - last requested in December 2024. At that time, he indicated that

The one remaining report is that of a neuropsychologist hired by the defense. The neuropsychologist holds an out-of-state license. During the pendency of this case his temporary New Hampshire license with the Board of Psychologists expired. When he attempted to renew that temporary license he was informed that it could not be renewed, but instead he would be required to apply for full licensure in New Hampshire to continue his work. That process is long, with multiple steps, and he has been working to obtain a New Hampshire license since this issue first arose.

3. Additionally, at the time of the last filing, defense counsel and the neuropsychologist believed that the licensing issue would resolve at the end of January 2025, leaving about a month until the March 1st deadline for final meeting and writing of the report.

4. The neuropsychologist's New Hampshire license was approved on February 13, 2025, and the neuropsychologist was able to do a follow-up meeting with Eric on February 21.

5. Since that meeting, defense counsel learned that one final visit to Eric is necessary to complete all required testing. That meeting is currently scheduled on March 4, 2025.

6. Eric respectfully requests that the Court extend the expert report disclosure deadline to March 17, 2025. After a March 4 meeting, the neuropsychologist has confirmed that the report will be complete by March 17. Again in turn, the State's expert deadline would also likely need to be extended, and Eric would not object to such an extension.

7. Given the current March 1 deadline, defense counsel has filed this Motion prior to hearing back about the State's position. Defense counsel will submit a supplemental pleading once it learns the State's position.

WHEREFORE, Eric prays the Court grant the within Motion, extending the defense deadline for expert disclosure of one report (the report of the neuropsychologist) to March 17, 2025. If not inclined to grant this Motion on its face, Eric respectfully requests that a hearing be scheduled on the matter.
