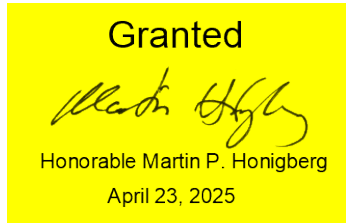

ASSENTED-TO MOTION TO CONTINUE MOTION HEARING

The defense, with the assent of the State, respectfully requests that the Court continue the motion hearing currently scheduled on May 1, 2025, for the reasons set forth below.

1. The Court scheduled a hearing on three motions to dismiss filed by the defense on May 1, 2025, at 2:00 p.m.

2. Undersigned counsel is scheduled to be out of state from Wednesday April 30, 2025, through Friday, May 2, 2025. Counsel is the Criminal Justice Panel Representative for the United States District Court for the District of New Hampshire. The United States First Circuit Judicial Conference is being held during that time period in the District of Puerto Rico with sessions for counsel on April 30, 2025, and all day on May 1, 2025. As the district's panel representative, counsel is expected by our local federal court to attend the conference. Prior to this Court's notice of the May 1st hearing, counsel purchased airline tickets and committed to attending the conference.

3. On behalf of the State, Sr. Assistant Attorney General Dan Jimenez assents to rescheduling the motion hearing.

4. Counsel have conferred and determined that all counsel and the accused are available any time on May 16, 2025, and on the afternoon of May 20, 2025, for the hearing. Counsel will

further confer with the Clerk as requested on other possible dates. The State notes that it is not available May 6, 9, 15, 19, or 23.

WHEREFORE, the defense, with the assent of the State, respectfully requests that the Court grant this motion and reschedule the motion hearing scheduled on May 1, 2025 to an available date as the Court's calendar permits.
