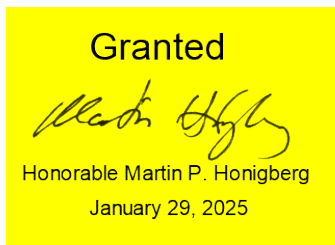

ASSENTED-TO MOTION TO CONVERT DISPOSITIONAL
CONFERENCE TO STATUS CONFERENCE AND TO
EXTEND DEADLINE FOR DISCOVERY MOTIONS

The defense requests, with the assent of the State, that the Court: (a) convert the dispositional conference scheduled for February 13, 2025, to a status conference, (b) schedule a new dispositional conference approximately thirty (30) days after February 13, 2025, and (c) extend the deadline for discovery motions until seven (7) days prior to the new dispositional conference, as set forth below.

1. Justice Anna Barbara Hantz Marconi is charged with Attempt to Commit Improper Influence, Criminal Solicitation (Improper Influence), Official Oppression, Criminal Solicitation (Official Oppression), Obstructing Government Administration, and two counts of Criminal Solicitation (Misuse of Position).

2. On December 23, 2024, the State provided an initial round of discovery to the defense. Both before and after that date, the defense requested discovery beyond what the State has provided.

3. As contemplated by N.H. R. Crim. P. 12(b)(6), the parties have scheduled a meeting to attempt to resolve discovery issues by agreement. The defense has provided the State with written lists of the defense discovery requests.

4. Since discovery is not complete, the parties have agreed to ask the Court to continue the dispositional conference currently set for February 13, 2025 for approximately thirty (30) days, and to convert the February 13, 2025 hearing to a status conference.

5. Considering the foregoing, the parties also agree that the deadline for discovery motions should be reset to seven (7) days prior to the new date for the dispositional conference.

6. Senior Assistant Attorney General Dan Jimenez assents to this motion on behalf of the State of New Hampshire.

WHEREFORE, the defense, with the assent of the State, respectfully asks the Court to (a) convert the dispositional conference scheduled for February 13, 2025, to a status conference, (b) schedule a new dispositional conference approximately thirty (30) days after February 13, 2025, and (c) extend the deadline for discovery motions until seven (7) days prior to the new dispositional conference, as set forth below.
