LIMITED APPEARANCE

NOW COMES, the New Hampshire Judicial Branch, by and through its counsel, and states as follows. Although limited appearances are typically entered in civil cases in which the scope of the representation is limited, in this case it is necessary for the Branch to enter a limited appearance of counsel in a different circumstance. The undersigned represents a third party to the instant litigation, subpoenaed judges. As such, the representation is not limited in scope but in subject matter: solely to those pleadings and hearings that pertain to the rights and responsibilities of the third-party judge-witnesses. The Branch has entered similar appearances in other instances in which witnesses from the Judicial Branch have been subpoenaed to give testimony relating to their official duties. *See, e.g., State v. Shawn T Phillips*, No. 211-2024-CR-671; *State v. James Russell Sweeney*, No. 201-2022-CR-1488.

Undersigned counsel does not currently envision that any pleading filed in the case, or any subsequent hearing held, will involve the third party she represents, save those pertaining to the pending Motion to Clarify judicial subpoenas.
