

on or about the fourth day of September, 2024, at Brentwood, in the County of Rockingham, with force and arms, did commit the crime of **OBSTRUCTING GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION (RSA 642:1)** by committing an unlawful conduct with a purpose to hinder a public servant, as defined in RSA 640:2, II, performing or purporting to perform an official function, to wit: testifying before the Rockingham Grand Jury that he did not communicate with and/or receive materials from Geno Marconi relating to the pier use permit of N.L. or words to that effect.

The said actions being contrary to the form of the Statute, in such case made and provided, against the peace and dignity of the State.
