STATE'S ASSENTED-TO MOTION TO EXTEND TIMEFRAME

NOW COMES the State of New Hampshire, by and through its attorneys, the Office of the Attorney General, and respectfully requests this Court extend the State's deadline to object to Defendant's pending motions. In support thereof, the State represents as follows:

1. On June 6, 2025, Defendant filed four motions in this case: two motions to dismiss, one motion to suppress, and one motion for judicial notice and jury instruction. The State had previously assented to a motion to extend Defendant's deadline from June 1, 2025.

2. The State's response to Defendant's pending motions would be due June 16, 2025. However, due to current caseloads and schedules, the State needs additional one-to-two days to file its objections to these four motions.
