

NOW COMES the State of New Hampshire, by and through its attorneys, the Office of the Attorney General, with the assent of counsel for Defendant, and respectfully requests this Honorable Court to extend the deadline for the state to file its motions to admit evidence at trial for seven (7) days. In support thereof, the State represents as follows:

1. On March 11, 2025, the Court issued a Status Conference Order in this matter setting jury selection for November 3, 2025, with a final pre-trial conference on October 15, 2025.
