BAIL ORDER

This Bail Order is by agreement after hearing

pending arraignment indictment trial sentencing appeal VOP that the above defendant:

- I. A. Be released on \$ _____ personal recognizance
- B. Be released on \$50,000 ~~cash or corporate surety~~ cash only, to convert to P.R. to transfer to

- II. DEFENDANT'S RELEASE IS SUBJECT TO THE CONDITIONS THAT: the N.H. State Hospital for I.E.A. Immediately upon discharge from that Hospital, bail shall automatically
- A. Defendant not commit a federal, state or local crime while on release.
- B. Defendant shall keep on file with this Court a current mailing address and check daily at that address for receipt of notices in this case.


III. The Court determines that because the above conditions will not reasonably assure the appearance of the defendant as required or will endanger the safety of the defendant or of any other person or community, the following additional conditions of release will be imposed:

- a. The defendant shall have no contact, direct or indirect, with Theresa Madore & Jacinto Madore
- b. The defendant shall live at _____
- c. The defendant shall not travel outside of New Hampshire
- d. The defendant shall execute a Waiver of Extradition approved by the Court revert back to cash only, with defendant to be transported to SC-HOC and a bail hearing to
- e. The defendant shall refrain from possessing a firearm, destructive device, dangerous weapon or ammunition
- f. The defendant shall refrain from ~~the excessive~~ ANY use of alcohol and the use of controlled drugs as defined in RSA 318-B
- g. The defendant shall comply with the following curfew: _____
- h. The defendant shall abide by all terms and conditions of probation and/or parole
- i. The CBPO dated _____ remains in full force and effect
- j. Strafford County Community Corrections be promptly held. *upon discharge for any reason, without conditions.
 - i. The defendant shall be supervised and monitored by Strafford County Community Corrections.
 - ii. Defendant shall be evaluated by Strafford County Community Corrections. If accepted by SCCC, bail shall convert to personal recognizance in the amount indicated in paragraph I.B., above. **Defendant shall not be released until bail bond is completed.**
 - iii. If defendant violates terms of this bail order, or of any provisions of SCCC supervision, bail shall revert to cash only, with a bail hearing to be scheduled.
 - iv. If SCCC supervision is ordered under paragraph III (j)(i) or (ii), it shall be according to whatever conditions that SCCC deems necessary for supervision. In addition, the following conditions shall apply:
 - 1. Electronic Monitoring
 - 2. GPS
 - 3. Sobriety
 - 4. Mental Health treatment referral
 - 5. Submit to random drug and/or alcohol tests.

k. Other: Strafford County Sheriff's Department shall provide all necessary transportation to and from NH Hospital.

l. Bail REVOKED / DENIED - The Court finds there is no condition or set of conditions that would ensure the Defendant's compliance
