PROCEDURAL ORDER

New Hampshire Public Radio ("NHPR") has filed a Petition To Unseal Records in this docket, to which the Strafford County Attorney's Office has responded. In order to ensure that all parties receive notice and an opportunity to be heard, and guided by the New Hampshire Supreme Court's direction in *Petition of Keene Sentinel*, 136 N.H. 121, 125 (1992) ("Procedurally, this case more appropriately should have been initiated by a petition for access to the sealed records."), the Court now orders as follows:

1. The clerk shall open a new docket captioned *Petition Of New Hampshire Public Radio* under a new docket number, into which the clerk shall transfer NHPR's petition and the State's response, and re-caption them;
2. Orders of notice will issue for service by NHPR upon the Strafford County Attorney, the Attorney General for the State of New Hampshire, and the defendant's estate via service upon his counsel of record in this docket.
3. The service package will include NHPR's petition, the Strafford County Attorney's response, and this order.
4. The orders of notice shall include the following deadlines: service to be completed by or before February 16, 2024; appearances to be filed by or before February 26; and a status conference to occur on February 27 at 3:00 p.m.
