

STATE'S REQUEST FOR WEBEX AT TRIAL

NOW COMES the State of New Hampshire by and through its attorneys, the Office of the Attorney General, and respectfully submits this request for the upcoming trial proceedings to be made available by WebEx. In support of this response, the State submits the following:

1. The defendant is charged with, inter alia, first-degree murder, and his trial is scheduled to begin with jury selection on March 12, 2024.
2. One of victim Christine Sullivan's family members (brother) is unable to attend the trial because of medical issues, and has asked that a request be made to have the trial proceedings be made available via WebEx.
3. The State recognizes that the Court has been very accommodating with respect to making pretrial proceedings available via WebEx upon request, and has done so several times. The State also recognizes that public access through WebEx or similar online mechanism is wholly discretionary with the Court, and that trial proceedings are very different from pretrial proceedings, which likely makes similar accommodation at trial not feasible. That being said, the State nevertheless makes the request.

WHEREFORE the State of New Hampshire respectfully requests that this Honorable Court:

- A. If feasible in connection with the upcoming jury trial, exercise its discretion and allow WebEx or similar online access to the trial; and
- C. Grant such further relief as may be just and proper.
