Trial Schedule Order

The court held a scheduling conference on November 7, 2023. Attorneys Meredith Lugo, Julia Nye, and Matthew McNicoll appeared for the defendant Timothy Verrill. Senior Assistant Attorney General Peter Hinckley and Assistant Attorney General Brian Greklek-McKeon appeared for the State. The purpose of the hearing was to select new trial dates following the continuance of the October 2023 trial.


Upon consideration of the various factors discussed during the scheduling conference, the court orders that the trial will begin with jury selection on March 12, 2024, and continue thereafter until the trial is concluded. The Clerk shall issue a scheduling notice of trial. In the event the trial continues through the end of April, there will be a half day of trial on April 25, 2024, ending at 12:00 noon, and no trial on April 26, 29 and 30, 2024. The Clerk shall also schedule a final pretrial conference approximately 3 weeks before the start of jury selection to address any remaining issues.

The court understands and is sympathetic to the issue that this schedule may result in Attorney Lugo not being able to represent Mr. Verrill at trial. A later trial date similarly would not guarantee her ability to participate in the trial. However, she will likely be able to assist the defense in preparation and provide litigation support. Mr. Verrill will be represented at trial by

highly experienced trial counsel. This case is nearly 6 years old and justice requires that it be scheduled and tried to conclusion.
