ORDER

The Court held a hearing on the defendant's renewed motion to enforce constitutional rights pursuant to its order dated December 20, 2022 on January 5, 2022. (See Court Index No. 290). Assistant Attorney General Grandy appeared with Commissioner Hanks and Warden Edmark. Attorney Harding appeared for the State. Attorney MacMachlan and Attorney Dolan appeared with Mr. Holloway. After an extensive discussion with counsel, Commissioner Hanks, Warden Edmark, and Mr. Holloway, the Court is assured that defense counsel and the Department of Corrections will work in a collaborative manner to establish a schedule for attorney-client visits over the next four months. While the court schedules of the attorneys and the visitation schedule of the prison remain fluid and subject change, it is imperative that defense counsel and the warden communicate in a timely manner to maintain the appropriate level of attorney access to Mr. Holloway for pretrial and trial purposes.

As such, the motion to enforce constitutional rights is denied without prejudice. Any attorney-client issues may be raised with the Court prior to trial by defense counsel on behalf of Mr. Holloway, the State, or the Department of Corrections.
