
Court ORDER for Contract Attorneys

Now Comes the Defendant, Dele E. Holloway Jr.,
PRO SE, PURSUANT to NH CONSTITUTION, PART
the first, ARTICLE 15, AND NHR, PROF. CONDUCT,
RULE 1.9, who respectfully Requests that
THIS HONORABLE COURT ORDERS the Contract
Attorneys (of record) to Relinquish file(s), inc-
luding Trial Notes, Letters, and Emails with HCR'S
office, for the preparation of His Self-Rep-
resentation in the above matter, for these
following REASONS:

1. The Defendant, Dele E. Holloway Jr., PRO SE

Has the Right to possess the file in the above CRIMINAL matter, AND the Right to Self-Representation, under BOTH STATE AND federal CONSTITUTIONS, as the file belongs to the DEFENDANT, AND NOT COUNSEL(S) OR CONTRACT ATTORNEY(S) of RECORD. See NH CONST. Pt 1, ART. 15; USCA CONST. AMEND. VI.

2. MR. Holloway's pro se litigation has developed New Discovery AND/OR (ADDITIONAL) Exculpatory Evidence that Contract Attorneys (of Record) possess. 


