Under oath, I Dale E. Holloway Jr. hereby Depose
and state that the following statements are
True and Accurate:

1. I am the Defendant in the above case.
2. I AM indigent.
3. I cannot afford private counsel for my representation in the above matter.
4. NHDOC/NHSP-M continues to allow situ supervisor Captain John Morin to interfere with access to legal work/material, including laptop with discovery files and trial notes, and photocopies.

5. No Access to Law Library Designated Area Has Become the intentional practice of the STH Supervision of NHSP-M under NADOC'S Custody while pretrial, post-conviction, and has impaired any preparation for any Hearings scheduled, including the TRIAL, during the TRIAL, AND NOW after the TRIAL, with a January 29, 2024 Sentence Hearing scheduled.

6. Therefore, I cannot complete any tasks for my defense and seek the court's direct order for access to legal work and legal material, including laptop, discovery files, and trial notes, with assistance for photocopies, as ordered by the court.
