Medical Departments, for the following:


1. The State accuses the Defendant of attempted Murder, First Degree Assault, Second Degree Assault, felon in possession of a firearm, and Simple assault charges.

2. NH R. Crim. Proc., Rule 17(b) Allows this Court to issue a subpoena to command the current Superintendent of [Suffolk County Jail] 200 Nashua Street Boston, Massachusetts to produce his [Complete] [Institutional Record], including booking photos, Videos, papers, D-reports, Documents, etc. Also, [Medical Records], for Rule 17(b) permits Mr. Holloway to seek its production through the service of a subpoena duces tecum. 3. The State has referenced Mr. Holloway's prior Conviction (Commonwealth v. Dale E. Holloway Jr., Docket Nos 0110467001 AND 002) and Rule 12(b)(1) of the NH Super. Ct. Rules for open discovery in the above-captioned matter. Rule 15(b)(5). Whereas, Mr. Holloway would like to obtain the specific discovery to offer at trial, pursuant to NH Rules of Evidence; USCA VI; NH CONST. Pt. 1, Art. 15.

Wherefore, the Defendant respectfully requests that this Honorable Court Issues a Subpoena to Command the Third Party Records to be produced and/or Allows or Grants this motion.
