## Motion to Sequester All Witnesses


Now comes the Defendant, Dele E. Holloway Jr., pro se, pursuant to NH R. Crim. Proc., Rule 15 (b)(1), who respectfully requests that this Honorable Court orders the sequestration of all witnesses during the course of the entire trial immediately after jury selection is complete and prior to the commencement of opening statements.

1. The Defendant additionally requests that the witnesses be instructed not to discuss any aspects of the case among themselves or with others during the course of the trial.
2. The only exception is that witnesses would be permitted to speak with ACA's prosecuting this case, or myself, as pro se counsel.

Such Sequestration is necessary to Ensure that  
the Defendant receives a fair trial.

Wherefore, the Defendant respectfully moves this  
Honorable Court with this Motion to sequester all  
witnesses during the course of the entire trial  
Immediately after Jury Selection is complete and  
prior to the commencement of opening statements.
