**STATE'S RESPONSE TO DEFENDANT'S EXPEDITED MOTION FOR
CONTINUANCE OF TRIAL MANAGEMENT AND HEARING (TRIAL)**

NOW COMES the State of New Hampshire, by and through the Hillsborough County Attorney's Office, and responds to the Defendant's pleading, stating in support as follows:

1. The defendant is charged with having shot two people and physically assaulted a third person on October 12, 2019.

2. The State incorporates its facts and arguments asserted in its pleadings, State's Response to Defendant's Motion to Transport Defendant to Courthouse for Mental Health Evaluation, Court Index #305, and State's Response to Defendant's Motion for Continuance of Criminal Mediation, Court Index #307.

3. The defendant claims in paragraph 9 of his pleading that the State will not be prejudiced by the request to continue the trial. The State disagrees. This case is approximately 3 ½ years old. Additional delay harms the victims.

4. The State notes that the Court (Temple, J.) at the hearing held on March 24, 2023 noted that the Court would grant the Defendant's motion to continue the trial, once filed.
