**STATE'S SUPPLEMENTAL OBJECTION TO CORRECT TYPOGRAPHICAL ERROR  
TO STATE'S OBJECTION TO DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO CONTINUE TRIAL**

NOW COMES the State of New Hampshire, by and through the Hillsborough County Attorney's Office, and hereby supplements its Objection to Defendant's Motion to Continue Trial to Correct Typographical Error, stating in support as follows:

1. On September 14, 2023, the State filed an Objection to the Defendant's Motion to Continue Trial. In paragraph 5, the State calculated that the number of days since the date of the incident that the case has pending to October 30, 2023 to total approximately 1,481 days. See ¶ 5 State's Obj. to Def. Mot. To Continue (Sept. 14, 2023).

2. The correct number of approximate days between October 12, 2019 – October 30, 2023 is approximately **1,480 days**.

3. The State files this Supplemental Objection to correct the typographical error as to the number of days between October 12, 2019-October 30, 2023.

WHEREFORE, the State respectfully requests that this Honorable Court:

- A. Deny the Defendant's Motion to Trial; or
- B. Schedule a hearing thereon, if necessary; and
- C. Grant the State any such other relief as may be proper and just.
