**MOTION TO CONTINUE TRIAL AND TO EXTEND ALL
DEADLINES BY 120 DAYS**


Defendant Danielle Dauphinais hereby moves to continue trial, and to extend all current deadlines, by 120 days. Dauphinais relies upon the following:

1. Dauphinais is charged with first degree murder, among other things.
2. Attorney Jaye Rancourt has been primary counsel and has represented Dauphinais since the beginning of this case.
3. Undersigned counsel was appointed as co-counsel on May 10, 2022.

While undersigned counsel is "up to speed" on the case, until now, Attorney Rancourt has been lead counsel.

4. Attorney Rancourt can no longer continue to represent Ms. Dauphinais.
5. Undersigned counsel will continue the representation but will need some time to come up to speed with information and tasks that had been being handled by Attorney Rancourt as lead counsel.

Subject to the filing of a Waiver of Speedy Trial. All applicable deadlines are suspended pending a Structuring Conference. This conference will be scheduled in September 2023. A Stipulated Case Structuring Order or Proposed Case Structuring Orders shall be filed by August 31, 2023.

6. New counsel will be joining the case as co-counsel.
7. New counsel will need time to review the voluminous discovery and familiarize herself with the relevant facts and law.
8. Continuance of trial and all deadlines by a period of 120 days will allow undersigned counsel and new co-counsel to be fully prepared.
9. Therefore, Dauphinais respectfully requests that this Court continue trial from January 2024 to May 2024 and extend all deadlines by a period of 120 days.
10. The defense has consulted with Ms. Dauphinais who expressly waives speedy trial for the purposes of the continuance sought in the within motion.

WHEREFORE, for all the foregoing reasons, Defendant Danielle D. Dauphinais respectfully requests that the Court GRANT the within motion and (1) CONTINUE the trial and (2) EXTEND all deadlines by a period of 120 days.
