It is hereby ordered that per RSA 597:2, the defendant shall:

**PERSONAL RECOGNIZANCE**

Be released on personal recognizance.

**CASH OR CORPORATE SURETY**

Be released on \$ \_\_\_\_\_  cash or  corporate surety bail.

The Court finds that this financial condition will not be the cause for pretrial detention, unless:

the Court determines by a finding of probable cause after a hearing that no reasonable alternative or combination of conditions will assure that the person will not commit a new offense, violate bail, or fail to appear OR

a hearing to determine the source of funds for bail is required before posting bail

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**BAIL ORDER**

**DETAINED**

- Be detained pursuant to RSA 597:2, III(a) - The Court determines by a finding of probable cause that such release:
  - Will not reasonably assure the appearance of the person as required OR
  - Will endanger the safety of the person or of any other person or the community AND/OR
- Be detained pursuant to RSA 597:2, III(b) - The Court determines by a finding of probable cause to believe that, on this matter or while on release pending resolution of a previous offense, the person: failed to appear; or committed a felony, class A misdemeanor, or driving or operating while impaired; or violated a condition of bail.
- Be detained for not more than 72 hours to allow for filing of a probation violation.

**JUDICIAL DETERMINATION ONLY:**

- The defendant shall be detained pending trial. The defendant is charged with a crime listed in RSA 597:2, III(c) and the court finds probable cause that release of the person is a danger to that person or the public.
- The defendant shall be held pending trial. The court finds probable cause that the person violated the conditions of his or her bail for any of the crimes listed in RSA 597:2, III(c).
- Preventive detention without bail: Pursuant to RSA 597:2, IX, the court finds probable cause to believe that the person poses a danger to another, after an arraignment for an offense listed in RSA 173-B:1, I, or charged with violation of a protective order issued under RSA 458:16, III.
- Bail shall convert to personal recognizance bail upon acceptance into a residential treatment program.  
Bail shall revert to  Personal Recognizance  \$ \_\_\_\_\_ Cash  Preventive Detention if the defendant is discharged from the program for any reason.  
After successful completion of the program, bail shall continue as  Personal Recognizance OR revert to  \$ \_\_\_\_\_ Cash  Preventive Detention

1.  Defendant shall not commit a federal, state, or local crime, must appear at all court proceedings as ordered, must advise the court in writing of all changes of address within 24 hours, and must comply with all civil domestic violence and stalking orders of protection.



**TAMPERING WITH WITNESSES AND INFORMANTS PURSUANT TO RSA 641:5**

A person is guilty of a class B felony if:

- I. Believing that an official proceeding, as defined in RSA 641:1, II, or investigation is pending or about to be instituted, they attempt to induce or otherwise cause a person to:
  - (a) Testify or inform falsely; or
  - (b) Withhold any testimony, information, document or thing; or
  - (c) Elude legal process summoning them to provide evidence; or
  - (d) Absent themselves from any proceeding or investigation to which they have been summoned;  
or
- II. They commit any unlawful act in retaliation for anything done by another in their capacity as witness or informant; or
- III. They solicit, accept or agree to accept any benefit in consideration of them doing any of the things specified in paragraph I.
