ORDER

LD-2010-0003, In the Matter of Brian J. Archambault

On February 19, 2010, the Attorney Discipline Office filed a certified copy of the January 20, 2010 order of the Massachusetts Supreme Judicial Court for Suffolk County immediately suspending Attorney Brian J. Archambault from the practice of law in Massachusetts on a temporary basis. It also filed copies of documents which show that Attorney Archambault pleaded guilty in Newburyport (Massachusetts) District Court to five counts of larceny over \$250.00.

Upon receipt of a certified copy of an order demonstrating that an attorney has been disciplined in another jurisdiction, the court may enter a temporary order imposing the identical or substantially similar discipline. See Rule 37(12). Accordingly, it is hereby ordered:

1. Brian J. Archambault is immediately suspended from the practice of law in New Hampshire on a temporary basis pending further order of this court. Attorney Archambault may show cause on or before ten days from the date of service why the temporary suspension should be lifted.
2. A copy of this order and of the Attorney Discipline Office's filing shall be served on Attorney Archambault by first class mail and certified mail, return receipt requested. A copy of this order shall also be sent to the Professional Conduct Committee by first class mail.
