ORDER

LD-2010-0009, In the Matter of Paula J. Green

On April 15, 2011, Disciplinary Counsel and Attorney Paula Green filed a stipulation and consent to disbarment. The parties stipulated that, in five separate instances, Attorney Green violated Rule 1.15(a) through (f) of the Rules of Professional Conduct by failing to properly safeguard client funds and maintain trust accounts. Attorney Green has waived her right to further proceedings before the Professional Conduct Committee and the Supreme Court. The parties request that the court find that Attorney Green violated Rule 1.15(a) through (f), and issue an order disbaring Attorney Green.

The court has reviewed the stipulation and consent to disbarment. It finds that Attorney Green violated Rule 1.15 (a) through (f) of the Rules of Professional Conduct. Considering the nature and severity of Attorney Green's misconduct, the court concludes that disbarment is the appropriate sanction in this case.

THEREFORE, the court orders that Paula J. Green be disbarred from the practice of law in New Hampshire. She is hereby assessed all expenses incurred by the Professional Conduct Committee in the investigation and prosecution of this matter.
