ORDER

LD-2012-0006, In the Matter of Richard Boire, Esquire

The Attorney Discipline Office (ADO) filed an assented-to petition for temporary suspension of Attorney Richard Boire from the practice of law pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 37(10)(b) and (c) on the ground that Attorney Boire is medically incapacitated and unable to practice law. Attorney Boire's spouse, Theresa Boire, who was appointed by Attorney Boire on July 8, 2003, to act as his attorney-in-fact under a Durable Power of Attorney for Financial Matters, assents to the relief requested in the petition.

In accordance with Rule 37(10)(b) and (c), Attorney Richard Boire is hereby suspended from the practice of law in New Hampshire pending further order of this court and a determination that he is medically able to practice law. This suspension shall be effective on the date of this order.

The pending disciplinary matter involving Attorney Boire is stayed pending review of Attorney Boire's medical condition and capacity to participate in the matter.

This order shall be public.
