**RECOMMENDATION TO ACCEPT RESIGNATION REQUEST**


On May 19, 2015, the Professional Conduct Committee deliberated the above captioned matter.

Mr. Mosca was admitted to the New Hampshire Bar on November 2, 1992. Mr. Mosca executed an affidavit on May 1, 2015, in which he states that he “acknowledge[s] that the material facts upon which [complainant’s] August 18, 2014 complaint . . . is predicated are true and accurate to the best of my knowledge and belief.” He submitted this resignation because he “know[s] that if charges were brought against [him] based upon the misconduct currently under investigation, they could not be successfully defended.” He “deeply regret[s] and take[s] full responsibility for all of [his] actions.”

Mr. Mosca admits to violating Rules 1.4(a)(3) and (4); 1.7(a)(2); 1.16(a)(1); and 8.4(a) of the Rules of Professional Conduct.

Upon consideration, the Committee voted to recommend to the Supreme Court that Mr. Mosca be allowed to resign from the Bar.
