In Case No. LD-2015-0007, In the Matter of Edward C. Mosca, Esquire, the court on June 10, 2015, issued the following order:

On May 19, 2015, the Professional Conduct Committee (PCC) submitted a request from Attorney Edward C. Mosca to resign in accordance with Rule 37(11), along with its recommendation that the resignation be accepted. As required by the rule, Attorney Mosca's request was accompanied by his affidavit in which he acknowledged that the material facts of the complaint against him were true and that misconduct charges could not be successfully defended. Attorney Mosca has agreed that a redacted copy of his affidavit, with the attached complaint, will be available for public review if his resignation is accepted.

The court has reviewed the affidavit of Attorney Mosca and the recommendation of the PCC. In accordance with Rule 37(11), Attorney Mosca's resignation from the bar is accepted. His resignation shall be effective on June 30, 2015.

The contents of this file shall be available for public review, with the exception of the original affidavit of Attorney Mosca. A copy of Attorney Mosca's affidavit, redacted to remove the name and other personal information about the complainant, shall also be available for public review.
