SUPREME COURT

In Case No. LD-2015-0010, In the Matter of Susan H. Hassan, Esquire, the court on August 4, 2015, issued the following order:

On July 21, 2015, the Professional Conduct Committee (PCC) submitted a request from Attorney Susan H. Hassan to resign in accordance with Rule 37(11), along with its recommendation that the resignation be accepted. As required by the rule, Attorney Hassan's request was accompanied by her affidavit in which she acknowledged that the material facts of the complaint against her were true and that misconduct charges could not be successfully defended.

In the affidavit, Attorney Hassan admitted that she violated Rules of Professional Conduct 1.3, 1.4, 8.4(c) and 8.4(a). In her request to resign, Attorney Hassan states that she has agreed to pay the costs incurred by the Attorney Discipline Office (ADO) in the investigation and pursuit of the disciplinary matter.

The court has reviewed the request to resign and affidavit of Attorney Hassan and the recommendation of the PCC. In accordance with Rule 37(11), Attorney Hassan's resignation from the bar is accepted. If Attorney Hassan should seek readmission to the New Hampshire bar in the future, she shall be required to take and pass the New Hampshire bar examination and the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE).
