RECOMMENDATION TO ACCEPT RESIGNATION REQUEST


On July 21, 2015, the Professional Conduct Committee deliberated the above captioned matter.

Ms. Hassan was admitted to the New Hampshire Bar on October 30, 2000. Ms. Hassan executed an affidavit on July 6, 2015, in which she states that she “acknowledge[s] that the material facts that gave rise to violations of certain Rules of Professional Conduct.” She request to resign, “because these facts would support charges against me for violations of the Rules of Professional Conduct that I could not successfully defended.”

Ms. Hassan admits to violating Rules 1.3; 1.4; 8.4(c) and 8.4(a) of the Rules of Professional Conduct.

Upon consideration, the Committee voted to recommend to the Supreme Court that Ms. Hassan be allowed to resign from the Bar. The Committee voted to assess costs incurred in this matter.
