RECOMMENDATION TO ACCEPT RESIGNATION REQUEST


On July 21, 2015, the Professional Conduct Committee deliberated the above captioned matter.

Mr. Whittenberg was admitted to the New Hampshire Bar on July 10, 2007. Mr. Whittenberg executed an affidavit on May 28, 2015, in which he states that he “acknowledge[s] that the material facts upon which the Amended Notice of Charges predicated are deemed to be true.” He submits “this resignation because the charges predicated upon the misconduct under investigation could not be successfully defended.”

Mr. Whittenberg admits to violating Rules 1.15; 8.1(b); and 8.4(a) of the Rules of Professional Conduct; also New Hampshire Supreme Court Rule 50.

Upon consideration, the Committee voted to recommend to the Supreme Court that Mr. Whittenberg be allowed to resign from the Bar. The Committee voted to assess costs incurred in this matter.
