In Case No. LD-2016-0001, In the Matter of Steven C. Kennedy, Esquire, the court on February 10, 2016, issued the following order:

On January 19, 2016, the Professional Conduct Committee (PCC) submitted a request from Attorney Steven C. Kennedy to resign from the bar in accordance with Rule 37(11), along with the PCC's recommendation that the resignation be accepted. The PCC's recommendation was accompanied by an affidavit of Attorney Kennedy, which satisfies the requirements of the rule. The PCC also recommended that Attorney Kennedy be assessed the costs incurred in the investigation and prosecution of this matter.

The court has reviewed the affidavit of Attorney Kennedy and the recommendation of the PCC. In accordance with Rule 37(11), Attorney Kennedy's resignation from the bar is accepted. Attorney Kennedy shall reimburse the PCC for the costs incurred in the investigation and prosecution of this matter.
