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

**Recommendation: Disbarment and Order on Costs**

On March 15, 2016, the Professional Conduct Committee (the “Committee”) deliberated the Stipulation; Stipulation as to Facts, Violations, and Sanction (the “Stipulation”) and the Agreement to Pay Costs of Disciplinary Matter (collectively, the “Record”).

Having reviewed the Record, the Committee approved the facts as stipulated, by clear and convincing evidence. The Committee approved the findings of violations of the New Hampshire Rules of Professional Conduct (the “Rules”) as stipulated and to recommend Disbarment for violations of Rules 1.8, 1.15, 3.2, 3.3, 3.4(c), 8.4(c) and 8.4(a), Supreme Court Rules 50 and 50-A, as well as reimbursement of the Committee for all costs of investigation and prosecution of this matter.
