**RESPONDENT’S REQUEST TO RESIGN UNDER SUPREME COURT RULE 37(11),
WITHOUT OBJECTION BY THE ATTORNEY DISCIPLINE OFFICE**

Respondent Brian D. Kenyon moves to resign as a member of the New Hampshire Bar, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 37(11).

1. Respondent was summarily suspended by the Supreme Court on December 6, 2023. *See* In the Matter of Brian D. Kenyon, Esquire, No. LD-2023-0016.

2. Respondent and the Attorney Discipline Office subsequently agreed upon conditions under which Respondent would conclude his practice. The conditions were expressed in a Joint [Proposed] Order. The Court adopted the proposed Order on January 2, 2024.

3. Respondent has since complied with the conditions of the Order.

4. Respondent has executed an Affidavit in Support of Resignation, which is attached to this pleading. The Affidavit contains all the information required by Supreme Court Rule 37(11).

5. The Attorney Discipline Office authorized Respondent’s counsel to report, here, that it has no objection to this Request, though the ADO will file its own pleading on the topic.

WHEREFORE, Respondent asks the Committee to file his Affidavit with the Court along with its recommendation that he be allowed to resign.
